School Bond Election

Adams County School District 0090
(Adams Central Public Schools)

In The State of Nebraska

"Shall Adams County School District 0090 (Adams Central Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a principal amount not to exceed Nineteen Million Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$19,720,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of acquiring a site in Hastings, Nebraska and constructing thereon a new elementary school building and related site improvements, including parking, playgrounds and sidewalks, and acquiring and installing necessary equipment and apparatus for such school building and site; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to become due at such time or times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and "Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

FOR said bonds and tax
AGAINST said bonds and tax

Electors voting in favor of said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words "FOR said bonds and tax" following said proposition, and electors voting against said proposition shall blacken completely the oval opposite the words "AGAINST said bonds and tax" following said proposition.
