



COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Courthouse, Clay Center, Nebraska, September 25, 2012 at 9:00 A.M.

The Clay County Board of Supervisors met September 25, 2012 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on September 19, 2012 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Chairman Fintel presided with roll call showing the following present: Nuss, Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw and Fintel. Minutes of the meeting held September 18, 2012 were mailed to the board members. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Chairman, Ivan Fintel stated that the open meeting law poster is posted on the west wall in the back of the room.

Motion by Samuelson and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the meeting held September 18, 2012 as mailed. On roll call, yea: Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson, Nuss and Fintel; abstain: Shaw. Motion carried.

There was no public input.

Thomas Roemmich II, Highway Superintendent reported that the project on Road 302 & Road B is done. The driveway work should be finished in a day or two. The new pickup has been delivered and is in use. Two companies were contacted for estimates for electrical work in the new motor patrol building in Edgar. Only one company replied so they were told to proceed.

An easement requested by Wanda M. Bauder for an electric line was discussed. Motion by Anderson and seconded by Samuelson to approve the easement requested by Wanda M. Bauder for an electric line across Road 311 from the NW ¼ Sec. 18-T6N-R6W to SW ¼ Sec. 7-T6N-R6W for powering a re-use pit pump — agricultural use only. On roll call, yea: Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson and Fintel. Motion carried.

The road work report was distributed. Motion by Nuss and seconded by Schmidt to approve the Highway Superintendent's road work report for the month of September 2012. On roll call, yea: Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson, Anderson and Fintel. Motion carried.

The Highway Supt. will run an ad or article advising landowners of their responsibility to mow and keep trees out of the ditches.

Bruce Rumsey, Weed Superintendent asked the board for a letter to be written to the Trailblazer RC&D in support of a grant application for electronic waste recycling collection.

Motion by Nuss and seconded by Samuelson to have the chairman sign a letter of support for the RC&D's electronic waste recycling project. On roll call, yea: Johnson, Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt and Fintel. Motion carried.

Bruce reported that Thayer County took in 31 tons of tires during their tire recycling so the Little Blue NRD is splitting the grant money left over between Nuckolls and Clay Counties. Fall spraying and inspections for Musk Thistle have begun. Leafy Spurge and Canada Thistle patches have been sprayed and the Rainwater Basins inspections are complete.

Jeff Franklin, County Sheriff reported that the electrical work is done and the Fire Marshall will be coming to do the inspection. Jeff is going to ask Joe Cooney to come and drain the freon from the freezer in the basement so that it can be cut up and removed. It may be necessary to





put up another awning to help water from entering the basement. The sidewalk has been completed. The board discussed landscaping around the building. The Sheriff said he would go along with whatever the board decided.

Travis Songster, Custodian reported that the downspouts for the Service Building are being made and once they are done they will be installed. All the repair work on the sidewalks have been completed. The courthouse lawn has been treated for grubs at no additional cost. Early October has been scheduled to have the courthouse system switched to heat. Travis will begin painting the men's restroom.

Supervisor Anderson told the board he had talked to Travis about housing his skid steer in the maintenance building so it would be ready for snow removal.

Supervisor Nuss reported on issues that were discussed at the Central District meeting which included the push to remove the Inheritance Tax money from the counties. Currently the county uses the Inheritance Tax for local programs, road projects and unexpected capital expenses. Other discussion at the meeting had to do with trying to find ways to build the road fund back up.

The County Clerk also reported on items of discussion at the Central District meeting. Audits and the results/consequences that other counties were experiencing were discussed.

Supervisor Anderson told the board that there are two cemeteries that the county has been paying someone to mow in the past that are not being mowed now.

At 11:00 A.M. the bids for the construction of the bridge known as Deweese South project #C-18 (256) were opened. The Highway Supt., Nuckolls County Highway Supt. and Nuckolls County Engineer were also present. Two bids were received. The bid from Theisen Construction Inc. was for \$125,001.31. The bid from Simon Contractors was for \$158,235.48. The board discussed the bids; consensus was that they were high.

Motion by Shaw and seconded by Anderson to accept the bid from Theisen Construction Inc. for Clay County Deweese South Project #C-18 (256) in the amount of \$125,001.31 contingent on Nuckolls County approval. On roll call, yea: Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson and Fintel. Motion carried.

Ted Griess, County Attorney did not meet with the board.

Motion by Shaw and seconded by Samuelson to approve the claims and authorize the County Clerk to issue warrants on the respective funds. On roll call, yea: Nuss, Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw and Fintel. Motion carried.
