



COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Courthouse, Clay Center, Nebraska, July 23, 2013 at 8:00 A.M.

The Clay County Board of Supervisors met July 23, 2013 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on July 17, 2013 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Chairman Fintel presided with roll call showing the following present: Nuss, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw and Fintel; absent: Samuelson and Anderson. Minutes of the meeting held July 16, 2013 were mailed to the board members. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Samuelson entered the meeting at 8:07 A.M.

The board reviewed the claims.

Chairman, Ivan Fintel stated that the open meeting law poster is posted on the west wall in the back of the room.

Motion by Nuss and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the meeting held July 16, 2013 as mailed. On roll call, yea: Samuelson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

There was no Public Input.

Thomas Roemmich II, Highway Superintendent reported that they had started on Road Q; they will put in culverts and a bridge. The asphalt projects in Trumbull, Inland, MARC east and MARC northwest have been completed.

The road work report was distributed. Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Shaw to approve the Highway Superintendent's road work report for the month of July 2013. On roll call, yea: Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss, Samueslon and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

Roy Vap, Big Iron Auction Company and Scott Wiese, Purple Wave Auction discussed how their respective companies operate and how they market and advertise to sell property. Commissions and time lines for auctions were also discussed. Shaw excused himself from the discussion.

Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Nuss to go with Big Iron Auctions for the sale of surplus Road vehicles and equipment. On roll call, yea: Johnson, Nuss, Samuelson, Schmidt and Fintel; abstain: Shaw; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

Tom will contact the companies to notify them of the board's decision.

Bruce Rumsey, Weed Superintendent reported that he has been trying to keep up with the spraying. The new sprayer is here but Bruce hasn't had time to work on it yet. There was ¾ of a truck load collected during the electronic recycling.





Jeff Franklin, County Sheriff did not meet with the board.

Loren Uden, Emergency Management Coordinator reported on the ICS Situational Unit Section Training that he attended last week. He will be going to Kansas City for the regional LEPC meeting. The E 911 grant application has been approved for \$47,652.82; the 2012-2013 EMPG reimbursements have been submitted and the county should receive around \$35,000.00. The 2012 EMPG monitoring visit went well; the county's policy for mileage, meals, lodging and vehicle reimbursement was viewed as deficient and suggested the policy be brought up to IRS poilcy. The Orion Damage Assessment software is ready and training will start next week.

Travis Songster, Custodian discussed the estimates received from Leichleiter Construction for sidewalk repair were discussed. The City of Clay Center was contacted about the placement of the sign pole on the southeast corner.

Motion by Johnson and seconded by Schmidt to accept the proposal from Leichleiter Construction for sidewalk repair for the Southeast Corner project for \$3700.00 and the Southwest Corner project for \$4200.00. On roll call, yea: Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson, Schmidt, Johnson and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

Travis also reported on sewer problems. The cast iron drain pipe is leaking at the top. The board asked Travis to call around for estimates on the pipe to do the work as soon as possible. The musty smell in the Assessor's office may be coming from the air conditioning unit which is rusting out as well. Travis will look into replacing the two units in that office.

Mark Newton, Viaero Wireless did not meet with the board.

Gretchen Wagner, Forensic Interviewer/MDT Coordinator for Central Nebraska Child Advocacy Center explained the services the non-profit organization provides to an 11 county district. They work with Health and Human Services, Law Enforcement, County Attorneys, Schools, Community Partners and Counselors as members of a multi-disciplinary team in each county.

Ted Griess, County Attorney answered questions from the board on setting wages for employees. Ted also was asked if he had worked with the Central Nebraska Child Advocacy Center. He explained the role they have in the quarterly meetings and court cases.

Motion by Shaw and seconded by Nuss to fund the Central Nebraska Child Advocacy Center for \$4000.00 for fiscal year 2013-2014. On roll call, yea: Nuss, Samuelson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

The General Misc. budget was reviewed. The budgets that have been presented will be given to the budget preparer, Gene Ulmer.

Wages were discussed but no decisions were made; this will be discussed again at the next meeting.





Motion by Samuelson and seconded by Nuss to approve the claims, except for General Fund Claim #350, and authorize the County Clerk to issue warrants on the respective funds. On roll call, yea: Samuelson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.

Motion by Schmidt and seconded by Shaw to deny General Fund claim #350 for \$222.00. On roll call, yea: Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Nuss, Samuelson and Fintel; absent: Anderson. Motion carried.
