



Clay Board of Equalization Minutes



COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDINGS

Courthouse, Clay Center, Nebraska, June 19, 2012 at 9:49 A.M.

The Clay County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Equalization met June 19, 2012 as per public notice given in the Clay County News on June 13, 2012 a copy of the proof of publication being on file in the County Clerk's Office. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice of the meeting. Todd Nuss, Vice-Chairman presided with roll call showing the following present: Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw and Nuss; absent: Fintel. All of the proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The advanced notice of this meeting stated that the time of this meeting could change depending on the Board of Supervisors schedule. Because the Board of Supervisors had openings on the agenda, this meeting started earlier than scheduled.

It was noted by Vice-Chairman Nuss that the open meeting law poster is posted on the west wall.

Motion by Shaw and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the meeting held April 17, 2012 as mailed. On roll call, yea: Anderson, Schmidt, Shaw, Samuelson and Anderson; abstain: Nuss; absent: Fintel. Motion carried.

Jan Stratman, County Treasurer was not able to be present but left the information to be presented for the exemption applications for tax exemptions on motor vehicles from Clay Center Christian Church and Sutton Community Home/Hillcrest View Assisted Living.

Motion by Samuelson and seconded by Schmidt to approve the exemption application for Sutton Community Home/Hillcrest View Assisted Living for renewal of a motor vehicle exemption on a 2007 Ford handicap van as recommended by the County Treasurer. On roll call, yea: Schmidt, Johnson, Shaw, Samuelson, Anderson and Nuss; absent: Fintel. Motion carried.

Motion by Anderson and seconded by Shaw to approve the exemption application for Clay Center Christian Church for renewal of a motor vehicle exemption on a 1992 Oldsmobile Van as recommended by the County Treasurer. On roll call, yea: Johnson, Shaw, Samuelson, Anderson, Schmidt and Nuss; absent: Fintel. Motion carried.
